## What do I need?

- Gloves
- Rubbish bag
- Something to keep time e.g. a watch

Litter picker (optional) How long will it take?

## What should I do?

- 1. Find a safe area with enough space to do the challenge, with some litter to pick up and a bin. This might be your street, a local park or even your messy bedroom!
- 2. Space yourselves out around the area and decide who will be going first.
- **3.** Choose one person to be the timekeeper.
- **4.** The first relay runner should **pick up as much litter as possible** in 10 seconds and put it in the rubbish bag.
- **5.** When the time is up pass the bag onto your teammate who does the same thing.

- **6.** Take a picture of all the rubbish you've collected to show us how well you're saving the planet!
- 7. The final relay runner should dash to a bin and empty the rubbish into it.
- **8.** Why not **repeat the challenge** and see if you can pick up even more litter the second time around?
